Celebrating 10 years of the Taranaki Arts Trail

Taranaki Arts Trail 2023 is celebrating its tenth trail and this milestone event has not happened without hiccups along the way ; Taranaki Arts Trail has grown, evolved and established itself, over the ten years, as the must-do New Zealand art experience.

The concept to hold a trail in Taranaki happened over a cup of coffee. After visiting other arts trails, discussions were had about how a trail could have a Taranaki twist. It didn't take long to decide on open studios to showcase Taranaki artists in their own spaces and to discuss their processes directly with the visitors but then the hard work started to actually make it happen.

Amanda Hewlett took the reins for most of the organisation of the first trail and one weekend in June was decided upon. Amanda was the treasurer and coordinator and many friends, colleagues and contacts were shoulder-tapped for their support. Leila Hunter approached established Taranaki artists to give a higher profile to the event. Dale Copeland became the first TAT patron, with Wayne Morris and Jeff Salisbury stepping up to help establish the first Taranaki Arts Trail. With Sue-Ellen Roy offering her design services free of charge, for the artists information folder, and the logo which we still use today.

It was all hands on deck around Amanda's kitchen table, with artists from all areas of the region helping put 5000 folders together and distribute them out. It was an exciting time with endless possibilities.

Many said that Taranaki Arts Trail was doomed for failure and tensions arose within the region through nerves and uncertainties but the first trail went ahead with 61 participating artists and 9500 visitors. The original team stayed on the committee for 2-3 years and then handed it over to new enthusiasts. There were moments through the years when it was touch and go if Taranaki Arts Trail would survive but it did and has gone from strength to strength. In 2020 when the Covid lockdowns struck, our June trail had to be postponed until spring and after much discussion over zoom Taranaki Arts Trail partnered with the then named, Taranaki Garden Festival for mutual benefit. Eighty five artists took part in 2020 and there were over 80,000 visitors to Taranaki. This change of seasons worked well and 98% of the artists voted to continue with a spring trail.

Another new committee was formed and it quickly grew from a one weekend arts trail to two weekends, aligning fully with the garden festival. The artists also had the option of opening their studios for the middle week, making it a 10 day trail for most.

Now in 2023, Taranaki Arts Trail sees an unprecedented 117 participating artists, unwavering confidence from local businesses, sponsors and supporters as well as a dedicated team of volunteers on the committee. Taranaki Arts Trail is at its best and will continue to evolve for many years to come while continuing to give visitors the ultimate art experience throughout Taranaki.

Taranaki Arts Trail 2023 team would like to thank the founders for persevering, Taranaki Arts Trail is a real creative asset to the region.




